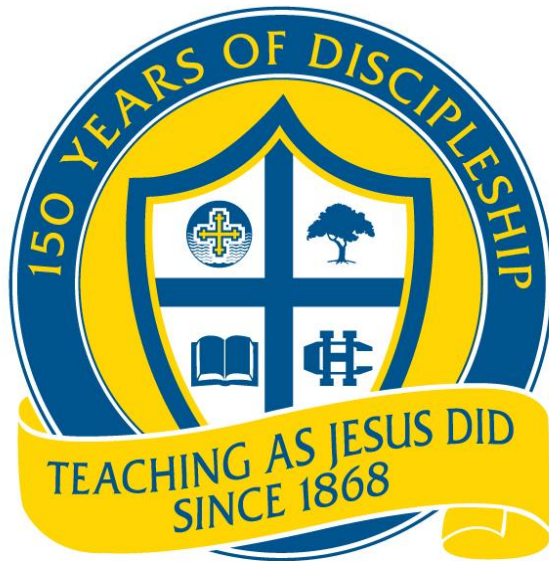

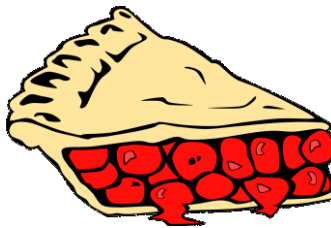

Auction Guidelines

- Values in the program have been provided by the donor and sold “as is,” “where is.”
- The buyer must contact the donor to arrange for the service. Please note the expiration date that may exist on some services.
- All Sales are final; no exchanges or refunds will be granted.
- To claim your merchandise, you must present a receipt from the cashier.
- Payment in full is due prior to item pickup.
- Payment may be made by check (made payable to GRACE) or cash. We can also accept MasterCard or Visa but are charged a fee for this.

Silent Auction

- Each table is coded and will close at the posted times.
- The successful bidder will be the last bid listed on the sheet at the close of each table.
- Each silent auction item has a corresponding bid sheet. Bidding is done by writing the bidder’s number on the bid sheet along with the bid amount.
- Check the bid sheets for more information about items, including any restrictions or expiration dates.
- Each item has a retail value set by the donor. The starting bid is up to 33% of the retail value.
- Each bid must exceed the previous bid by a minimum of \$2, \$5 or \$10
- In the event of a dispute, an auction chairperson will determine the winning bidder. The auction chairperson’s decision is final.

Oral Auction

- All bidding is done using your bid number assigned to you on the back of your auction booklet. When placing your bid, raise your booklet to be recognized by the auctioneer.
- The auctioneer has the authority to decide who has the winning bid and to settle any disputes.
