
Miss Barrett will be taking over the 4th grade teaching position.

Site Advisory Council Update

The Site Advisory Council would like to update, congratulate, and thank everyone for their hard work, dedication and generosity in supporting Catholic education at Holy Cross Catholic School. As you know, SAC is tasked with the duty of generating the Third Source Funding (TSF) amounts that are needed for GRACE and Holy Cross to educate our children. Your dedication to Catholic education has again accomplished and surpassed these objectives!

Third Source Funding (As of 3/31):

- Goal-\$57,300 (The amount we must raise as our subsidy to GRACE for the 17/18 school year.)
- Auction Income: \$45,921
- Other Fundraising Income: (Magazine Sales, Fall Fest, etc.) \$20,414
- Excess from 17/18 Fundraising: \$9,035
- Items SAC purchased this year for the school: Emergency evacuation backpacks for all the classrooms, bookshelves in the middle level language arts room, new chairs in the kindergarten room, document camera, standing desks for middle level classroom, Bluetooth speaker, risers for our portable stage, and new furniture for the 1st and 2nd grade classrooms.

*Excess SAC funds can be spent on items suggested by the Principal and agreed to by SAC.
