Hello, Holy Cross:

As you know, the Holy Cross Before After Summer Care (BASC) Program will be under GRACE management beginning June 6, 2022 and we are looking forward to another fun summer at Holy Cross. All children enrolled and attending the Holy Cross Summer Care portion of BASC need to be four (4) years old by June 1, 2022 and potty trained. Our Summer Program will run from June 6th to August 12th with the exception of July 4th. We will be open from 6:30 AM to 5:30 PM (Monday - Friday).

Included in this packet:

Registration Paperwork will be required to secure a spot for your child/children.

Weekly Schedules/Payment to get you started. Schedules may change weekly, however, we will need a schedule and payment slip turned in on Fridays by noon prior to the week of care. (Example: schedule and payment for the week of June 20-24 is due by noon on June 17th.) Your balance will be provided every two weeks.

Sunscreen/Bug Spray Permission Slip to allow staff to help apply sunscreen and/or bug spray. Please bring in a bottle of sunscreen/bug spray on the first day your child attends with your family name written on the

bottle in permanent marker. Spray on lotions do not work well as wind makes application a challenge.

Medication Form will be required for any medication that needs to be administered for your child while he/she is in our care including dosage and required time of administration.

Daily Notes:

Arrival/Departure - Please bring your children to the gym doors (Door #3) where we will meet you and sign your child in/out when you arrive and depart each day. Parents are asked to remain outside the building at drop off/pick up.

Morning Snack / Afternoon Snack / Lunch - We will schedule a morning and afternoon snack time for the children. These will need to be brought from home each day your child attends. Lunches will be stored in the refrigerator until lunch time.

Water Bottles - Children will need to bring their own water bottles from home each day. These can be refilled as necessary throughout the day.

Lockers - Children attending will be provided a small locker for an extra change of clothes, bathing suit and a towel.

Rest Time - After lunch, those that have just completed Kindergarten or are younger will have rest time. Blankets and stuffed animals may be brought from home. Those children who have just completed first grade and/or are older will have quiet reading time. Chapter books are encouraged to be brought from home.

Please return the necessary registration form, permission slip and medication form (if applicable) to the Holy Cross School Office by May 16, 2022. We are excited to see the children back here with us this summer!
